RESOLUTION OF SIGNIFICANT SAFETY CONCERNS (SSCs) — URUGUAY

1. The Council, at the twelfth meeting of its 179th Session, approved the mechanism for addressing Significant Safety Concerns (SSCs) identified during the conduct of safety oversight activities under the Universal Safety Oversight Audit Programme (USOAP).
2. In April 2014, ICAO identified two SSCs pertaining to the certification process for the issuance of air operator certificates and the approval of aircraft modifications and repairs in Uruguay. In accordance with the mechanism approved by the Council, the State has implemented corrective actions to resolve these SSCs. As a result, the SSCs are no longer posted on the ICAO USOAP CMA online framework (<http://www.icao.int/usoap>).
3. Presently, eleven SSCs identified by ICAO remain unresolved. The ICAO Member States with unresolved SSCs that remain posted on the secure website are the following: Angola, Djibouti, Eritrea, Georgia, Haiti, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Malawi, Nepal and Thailand.
