

# MONTALUCE WINERY AND DAHLONEGA

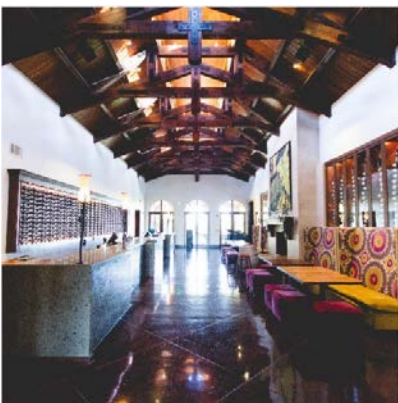
A POST-AGM SOCIAL OUTING FOR PROFESSIONAL NETWORKING AND RELATIONSHIP  
DEVELOPMENT

WEDNESDAY MAY 9, 2018

The IFALDA leadership has organized a tour of the North Georgia Mountains the day after the IFALDA Annual General Business Meeting for the purpose of developing and enhancing professional relationships formed at the AGM in an informal setting.

The tour will depart the Hilton Gardens Inn at 0930 Wednesday morning on a chartered bus. Additional transportation will be provided, if necessary for overflow, in privately owned vehicles of local IFALDA members. The trip will take about 1 ½ hours from the hotel to the Montaluce Winery in Dahlonega, GA, which is in the mountains of North Georgia.. The tour will include a tour of the winery and vineyards, a wine tasting and lunch at the restaurant at the winery. The cost of the tour is \$25.00 per person, which will include transportation, the winery tour and the wine tasting. Lunch will be at the expense of the individual. Lunch prices vary from about \$15.00 to about \$50.00 depending on how hungry you are and your taste in wine accompanying lunch. There is also a shop at the winery where you can purchase wine by the bottle and other wine accessories. After lunch the bus will stop in the town of Dahlonega, about 10 minutes from the winery, for shopping and sightseeing. Dahlonega is a small college town with numerous antique shops, pubs, wine-tasting shops and restaurants. The local area is famous for its gold and silver mines and numerous vineyards. It is particularly famous for the Fudge Factory on the town square. The stop in Dahlonega will be about 2 hours and the bus will return to the Hilton Gardens Inn about 1830, depending on traffic.
